

# ACTIVE LIVES CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE SURVEY


## Information for teachers co-ordinating and completing the questionnaire

**Thank you for agreeing to take part in the Active Lives Children and Young People survey. This is a national survey that is key to understanding how children and young people engage with sport and physical activity, both in and out of school. It is the largest survey of its kind and focuses on children age 5-15.**

The data collected from the pupils at your school will be invaluable in understanding not only their levels of participation but also attitudes to sport and physical activity which will ultimately help shape future policy and investment.

In appreciation, schools meeting the completion criteria will be eligible to receive their own specific school report, as well as being entitled to select a sports equipment reward as a thank you from Sport England.

The survey is carried out by Ipsos MORI on behalf of Sport England and Government departments with support from a national network of Active Partnerships (APs) who work in partnership with us to support local communities.

### Lead Teacher

We would like you to:

- 1. Coordinate the pupil survey**  
See the checklist on page 2.
- 2. Complete the teacher survey**  
You will be provided with a URL (weblink) and teacher survey login by your AP which you should use to access the surveys.

If you are unable to complete the teacher survey in one sitting, your answers will be saved until the next time you log in.

### Class Teacher

**Your class has been randomly selected to complete the survey.**

This can be completed on a laptop, desktop computer, smartphone or tablet that has access to the internet.

The survey should take pupils around 20 minutes to complete.

# TEACHERS' CHECKLIST

## Lead Teacher

### Contact parents

Write to parents to inform them that their child has been selected to complete the survey. Example templates can be downloaded via the link below.

### Check facilities

Arrange computer or tablet access with internet connection and whitelist the survey domain (including sub-domains). Not relevant if pupils are completing at home.

### Check your URLs

Your AP will send a unique URL for each class, parent and teacher survey. Ensure each class has the correct link.

### Contact parents (Years 1&2)

Remind parents to complete the survey with appropriate URL.

### Ask Class Teachers to conduct the Pupil Survey

Provide each class teacher with their unique URL and the checklist in the right hand column.

### Complete the Teacher Survey

You will be provided with a URL and teacher survey login by your AP.

### Once completed

Let your AP know that the questionnaires have been completed and how many pupils opted out.

You will be contacted by ESPO to select your sports equipment reward once the survey has been completed and response numbers verified. The school report will be sent to you in the term following completion.

## Class Teacher

### Check your URLs

Use the test URL provided beforehand to view the questionnaire. The correct survey URL for your class should be used when completing the survey.

### Share information sheets

Share relevant information sheets with pupils completing the questionnaires. Download these via the link below.

### Talk through the screens

We recommend that teachers talk the class through the first few screens of the survey using the test URL. Not relevant if pupils are completing at home.

### Help pupils open the URL

Access the survey using the unique URL for your class. You can create a shortcut on the desktop for pupils to click on the URL, rather than each child having to type it in. Not relevant if pupils are completing at home but they may need some support from a parent or guardian.

### Complete in one sitting

Pupils will not be able to return to the survey to complete it. Answers will be automatically submitted.

### Audio option

Years 1&2 only (if required), can select the audio icon (headphone symbol) for the questions to be read out.
