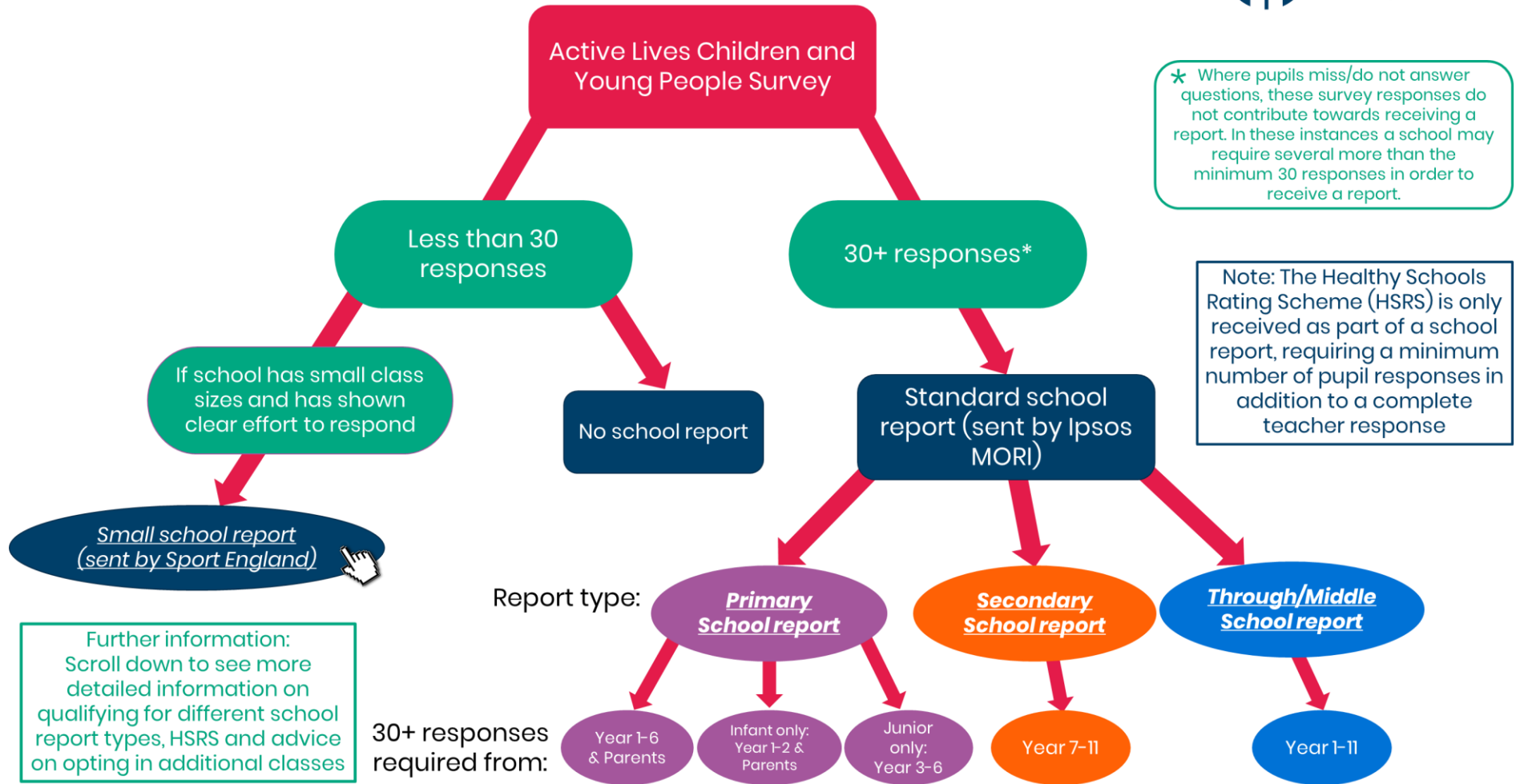


School reports – Who receives a report?



* Where pupils miss/do not answer questions, these survey responses do not contribute towards receiving a report. In these instances a school may require several more than the minimum 30 responses in order to receive a report.

Note: The Healthy Schools Rating Scheme (HSRS) is only received as part of a school report, requiring a minimum number of pupil responses in addition to a complete teacher response

Small School Reports

- Small school reports, first sent to schools in June 2019 for Autumn Term 2018–2019 onwards, are designed to share Active Lives Survey results with small schools that are unable or unlikely to reach the required responses for a standard school report due to the size of the school.
- Note that as Sport England become more familiar with producing small school reports, the criteria to qualify for a report may be subject to change.
- Unlike standard school reports a minimum of 10 responses are required to present data in small school reports. Because of the lower response numbers in small school reports, figures are presented as numbers rather than percentages.

	Requirement
To receive a report	10–30 (behavioural and/or attitudinal) responses from Years 1–11 and Parents and clear effort shown to complete the survey, measured by the response rate (number of responses / number of pupils in sampled classes)
To have figures for questions relating to activity levels (behavioural data) e.g. % active every day	10+ responses from Years 1–11 (either) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 10+ responses from pupils in Years 3–11 - A total of 10+ responses, when responses from pupils in Years 3–11 and from parents of pupils in Years 1–2 are combined
To have figures for attitudinal questions for Years 1–2 e.g. Happiness (“ <i>How do you feel today?</i> ”)	10+ responses from Years 1–2
To have figures for attitudinal questions for Years 3–6 e.g. Resilience (“ <i>If I find something difficult, I keep trying until I can do it</i> ”)	10+ responses from Years 3–6

Healthy Schools Rating Scheme (HSRS)

The Healthy Schools Rating Scheme is only provided as part of a school report. Schools are unable to qualify for the HSRS without the required pupil responses needed to qualify for a school report.
