















Safeguarding Training Map - November 2021

This safeguarding training map has been produced in collaboration between Sport England, UK Sport, Ann Craft Trust, Child Protection in Sport Unit, LimeCulture, NWG Network, UK Coaching and Chartered Institute for the Management of Sport and Physical Activity. These organisations are all involved in safeguarding children and young people and/or adults at risk. Some transform lives and communities through sport and physical activity (Sport England) or enable Olympic and Paralympic sports and athletes to achieve their full medal winning potential (UK Sport). Others develop the sport and physical activity workforce (UK Coaching and Chartered Institute for the Management of Sport and Physical Activity) and have specialist safeguarding expertise (Ann Craft Trust, Child Protection in Sport Unit, LimeCulture and NWG Network).

This has been produced to help guide the sport and physical activity sector on the variety of safeguarding training that is available. It is intended to be thorough, though not complete as new training opportunities (in response to emerging safeguarding themes) are constantly being developed and released.

For children and young people, Working Together to Safeguard Children (2018) includes the requirement for all organisations working with children to receive appropriate safeguarding training. For adults at risk, The Care Act (2014) created a legal framework to support and protect them including appropriate safeguarding training.

E-learning training is conducted online where individuals learn in their own time. Face-to-face training is in a real-world location where individuals learn together in person. Virtual learning environment training is live in an online location, where individuals learn together remotely.



- select the appropriate level of training for that role in accordance with your National Governing Body guidelines. Please check the bottom of each page for a list of safeguarding training providers.


